- 2) Conditions of covers: in most cases (except modern F.D.C's etc.) minor creasing and/or age-staining/tropicalisation are the norm and are not mentioned unless they are unsightly.

V.A.T.

Buyers resident in the E.E.C. or taking delivery of lots at the auction will be liable to pay V.A.T. at the standard rate on those marked with the symbol 'T' in the catalogue. Overseas buyers are exempt from paying V.A.T. if the lots are posted to an address outside the E.E.C.

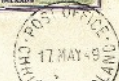

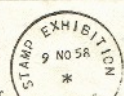

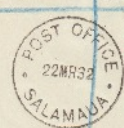
